We are approaching Pentecost Sunday, which this year falls on the 31st May.

In the Book of Acts, in the 2nd Chapter verses 1 to 4 we read: 'When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.

And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting.
