Joseph, who was thrown into a pit by his jealous brothers, sold into slavery, then subsequently falsely accused and sent to prison (Genesis 37 & 39)

- David, when he wrestled lions, bears and slew Goliath (1 Samuel 17)
- Noah and his family, who remained safe in the ark whilst the waters covered the face of the earth (Genesis 6:8)
- The Disciples, in the boat with Jesus as He calmed the storm (Matthew 8 & Mark 4)
