## Thought for today...

"Don't waste that!" You've no doubt heard someone say that, or indeed said it yourself. Perhaps the thing being referenced was edible, or maybe an object - whatever the item, it was likely deemed of no further use or value by the person making the decision to discard it.

It may come as a surprise then, that someone else sees beauty or value in it, or perhaps has the vision to see how the item might be used differently if reshaped, altered or lovingly restored. As the saying goes "One man's waste is another man's treasure."

There may be times in our lives when we feel like an item that has been, or should be discarded! We may feel that we are past our best, or have no use or value.

Genesis 1:27 reminds us that '...God created mankind in His own image, in the image of God he created them; male and female he created them.' (NIV)



If it is true that God created us in His own image - and I contend that it is true - then I am convinced that He would not create anything that is without beauty, value or purpose.
